We provide the following information regarding bookings for a night at Pacers Restaurant, Newcastle Paceway.

Pacers Restaurant is located opposite the winning post spread over 4 tiers with an uninterrupted view of the race track.

The restaurant has a capacity of approx. 270, is fully glassed in and air conditioned. Bar and TAB facilities are available.

Table settings are arranged so that your group is placed on tables of best fit all next to one another, we don't mix groups on tables.

TIME

Pacers Restaurant will open on all Friday & Saturday night fixtures.

Most race meetings have 8 or 9 races, with the first race commencing anytime from approx. 5.00 pm and concluding with the last race between 9.30 pm & 10.30 pm. (Race times are confirmed Wednesday prior to Race Meeting)

The Restaurant is open from approximately 6.00 pm with orders taken between 6.00 pm & 7.00 pm.

BOOKING

Reservations can be made for any number of guests. A booking in Pacers Restaurant includes reserved table/s with unrestricted views of the track. Special requests and functions are happily accommodated. Please contact the Admin office for further assistance.

FINAL NUMBERS

NEWCASTLE HARNESS RACING CLUB HOUSE POLICY ON THE RESPONSIBLE SERVICE OF ALCOHOL

- This club recognises that it is against the law to serve any person who is intoxicated.
- This club recognises that it is against the law to serve or supply alcohol to any person under the age of 18 years.
- This club recognises it is against the law for other people to obtain alcohol on behalf of people under 18 years of age.
- This club recognises that it is against the law to allow intoxicated, disruptive, violent or inappropriate behaviour to occur on the premises.
- This club seeks to ensure that no harm comes to patrons as a result of our service of alcohol.
- A range of drinks are available on these premises, these include a range of non alcoholic beverages and water.
- This club does not seek to encourage rapid or excessive consumption of alcohol through pricing.
- Low alcohol beers and non alcoholic beverages are stocked and promoted.
- Staff have been acquainted with this house policy & trained to implement it.
- If a staff member feels that a patron is becoming intoxicated, they will offer a range of options as an alternative to alcohol consumption.
- If such patron continues to order alcoholic beverages the staff member will contact the Bar Manager, the General Manager or RSA Supervisor and alert them to the patrons current or impending state of intoxication.
- The senior staff person will determine whether or not service should be refused.
- If service is refused the senior staff person will politely explain to the patron/s that the club cannot legally serve alcohol to the point of intoxication.
- If in the staffs opinion the person is intoxicated they will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- If a staff member believes that a person who is ordering or being supplied alcohol is under age they will politely request proof of age identification. If the person is under 18 yrs of age or refuses to supply identification, staff will refuse service and request the senior staff to ask the person to leave the club.
- All incidents should be reported to the Bar Manager, the General Manager or RSA Supervisor or Security, who will record them in the incident book.
- This club does not allow intoxicated persons to enter the club.
- If a staff member notices a person/s behaviour to become disruptive, violent or inappropriate they will contact the manager or security. If the behaviour is not reduced the senior staff member or security will ask the person/s to leave the premises. If the person refuses, the police will be called.
- Staff members will discourage person/s who appears to have a blood alcohol limit higher than the legal limit from driving.
- This club offers a number of services designed to discourage drinking and driving such as calling taxis, overnight parking, holding keys in a safe place.
